# Christmas Cookies

## What you'll need

- 2 cups all-purpose flour
- 3/4 cup granulated sugar
- 2/3 cup butter - softened
- 1/4 cup powdered sugar
- 1 large egg
- 1 1/2 teaspoons baking powder
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1/4 teaspoon salt



## How to make it

Heat oven to 375° F.

Cream together butter and sugar until light.

Add vanilla and egg and stir until well combined.

Stir in flour, baking powder and salt until a soft dough forms.

Shape dough into a flat disc and wrap in waxed paper or plastic wrap and refrigerate at least one hour before rolling.

Dust rolling surface with an equal mixture of all-purpose flour and powdered sugar. Roll dough to 1/4-inch thickness and cut into desired shapes.

Place cut cookies onto a baking sheet prepared with cooking spray or covered with parchment paper.

Decorate with coloured sugar or other decorations as desired.

Bake for 8-10 minutes or until very lightly golden.

Cool on baking sheet for 2 minutes before removing to racks to cool completely.



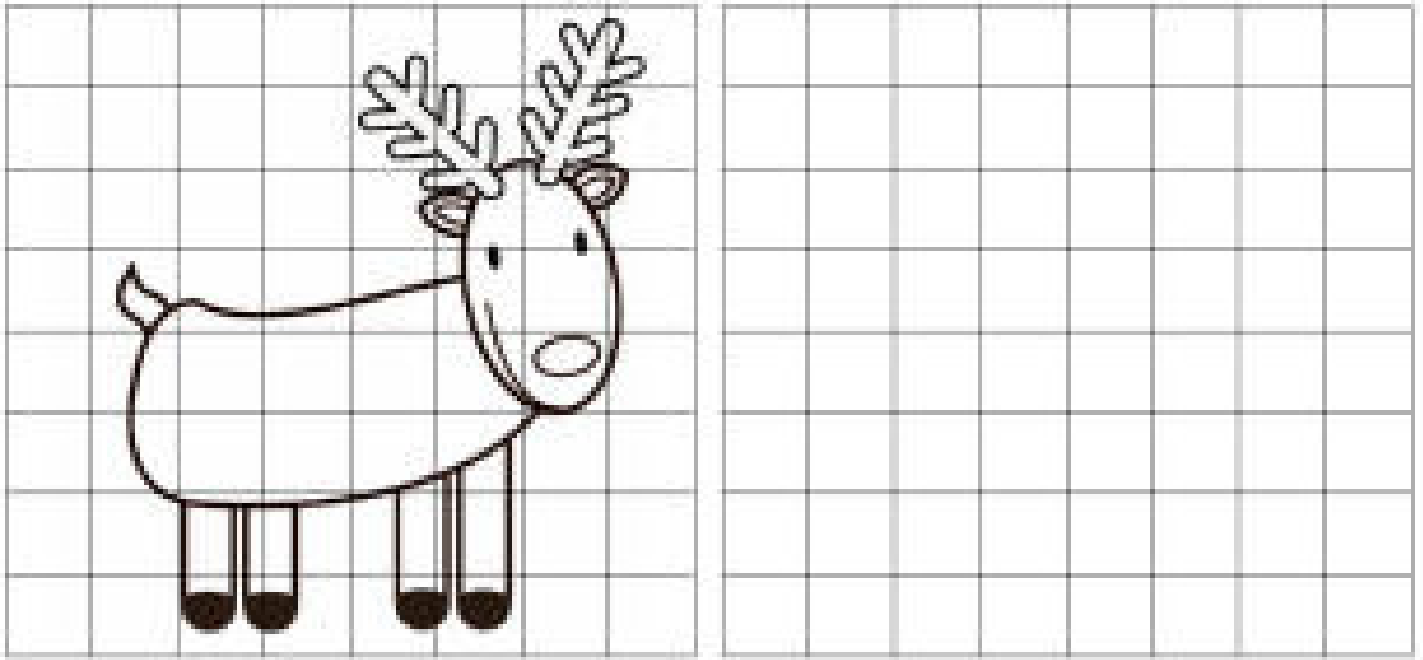

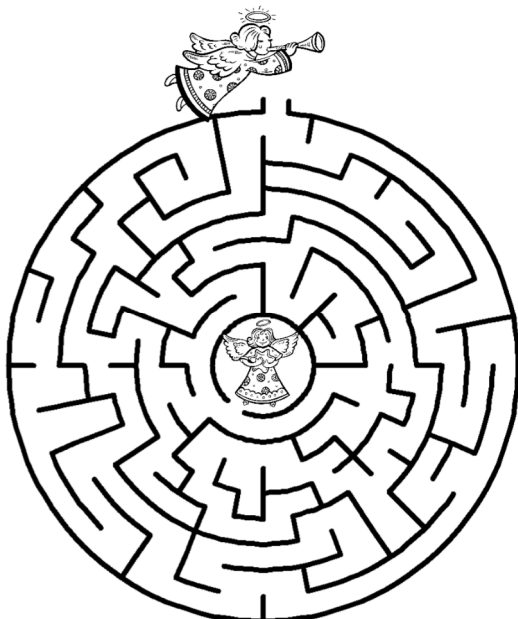

# Journey of the Celts

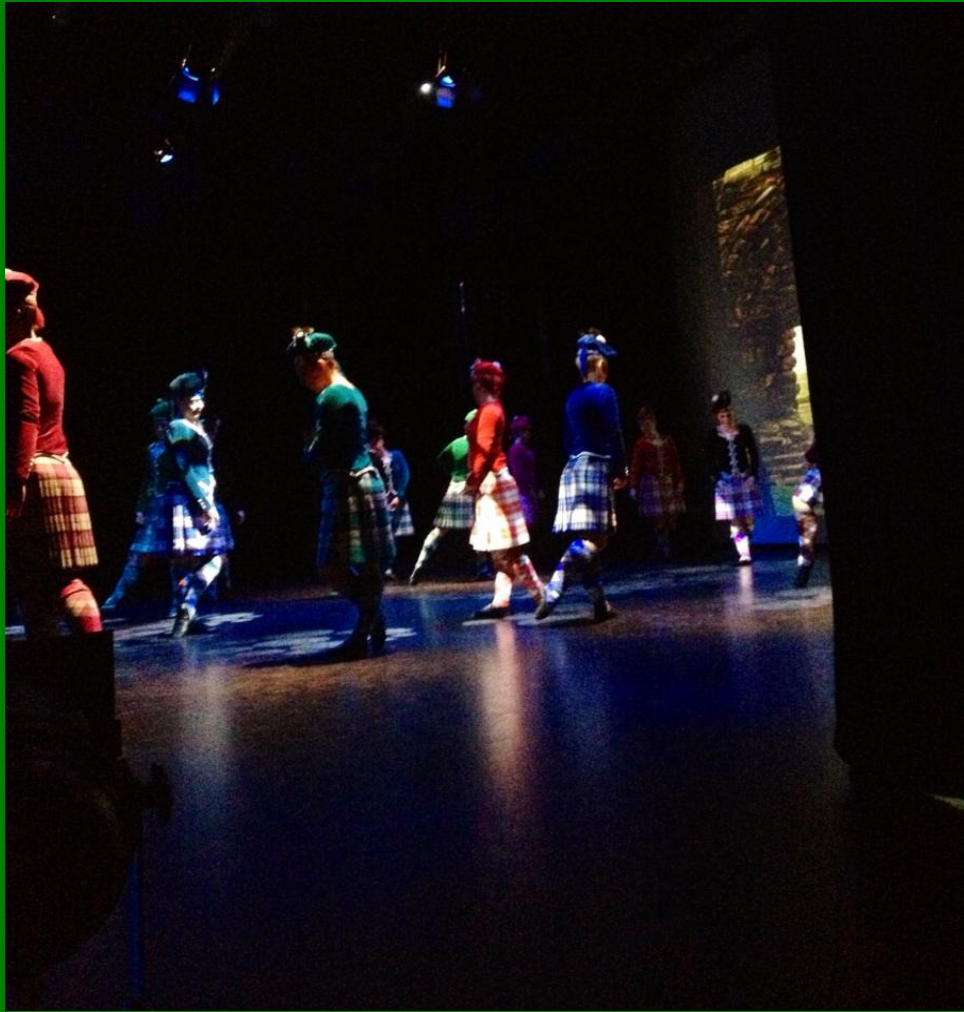
Journey of the Celts was a huge success for the Highland Dance Company of New Zealand. Producing two shows in both Christchurch and Blenheim.
